John's parents were Jeremiah PAGE and Ann [RAVEN] who were married in Topcroft in 1797. Sixteen years after John's first wife Ann [LEGOOD] died, he married in Hempnall widow Martha [PRESTON] GOOSE (born Kirby Cane, Norfolk). In 1851, John and Martha are recorded living in Hempnall with Martha's sons John and Cornelius GOOSE. Martha died in 1879, six years after her husband.

Robert's parents were Robert ARMES, agricultural labourer and Parish Clerk of Horsford, Norfolk, where he was born, and Rachel STEWARD, of Buxton, Norfolk, who were married in 1845 (first quarter, St Faith's District). Robert (junior) was born later that year. This was Robert senior's second marriage, his first being to Eliza (1841 census), probably to be identified with Elizabeth HOWARD whose marriage to Robert ARMES in Horsford in 1831 is recorded in the IGI. Someone has put an apparently bogus record in the IGI for a marriage of Robert ARMES and Rachel STEWARD in St Faith's in 1837, dated to precede the birth of the oldest child appearing in the 1851 census (Susanna age 13). The 1841 census record for the family is difficult to find because the surname looks like "ANNES". It shows parents Robert and Eliza (not Rachel), and children of the first marriage Sarah (7), James (5), Susan (4) and William (1). See the note attached to Robert Henry ARMES to the right on this chart. He is son of James, and grandson of Robert and Eliza.

Although this person's civil birth registration is for Ann PAGE, her baptismal record (Hempnall registers fiche 10) is for Judith PAGE daughter of William & Judith. Either a mistake or a change of mind. She appears as Ann in censuses, and in her marriage registration.

Judith was baptised daughter of William BALDWIN (labourer) and his wife Elizabeth [GOSLING] in Hempnall in 1827.

Walter's parents were Thomas Henry DYE, a gardener born in Norwich, and his wife Mary Ann [SOWTER] from Clerkenwell, who were married at All Saints, Norwich in 1843. (The IGI record of this marriage has the names Thomas Hardy DYE and Mary Ann LOWTER.)

Janet's parents were bricklayer James BARLOW and his wife Emma [WARD] who were married in 1853. Although Janet was born in Sunderland, both her parents were born in Norwich where they were married, and Janet's older and younger siblings were also born in Norwich, so the family can have been in Sunderland for only a short time.

Birth registered as Alice Helena PAGE. Baptised as Alice Selina PAGE. Married as Alice Eleanor PAGE.

I believe that possibly Alfred FAIRMAN was born out of wedlock. His mother was born Mary Ann MEAD, and married Samuel FIRMAN (GRO marriage entry spelling) in 1846.

Samuel died in 1847 (GRO death entry spelling Samuel FAIRMAN). In the 1851 census, Mary is widow, age 25, with 2 children, Robert (4) and Mary Ann (3), and is with her parents Stephen & Susan MEAD.

Alfred FAIRMAN was born in 1851 (4th quarter).
Mary [MEAD] FAIRMAN married George GRIX in 1856. He was also widowed with children. In the 1861 census, Alfred is recorded as George's son-in-law (meaning stepson).

William's parents are thought to be William BATCH cord wainer, and Elizabeth [ARNUP] who were married in 1858 in Norwich.

Robert's parents were James ARMES, groom and gardener, and Elizabeth ROBINSON whose marriage was registered in Freebridge-Lynn r-d in 1862. James was half-brother of Robert Stewart ARMES who was already married to Emma's eldest sister Ann (see the note attached to Robert Stewart ARMES to the left on this chart).
