

FLEURY of Stuttgart, Germany

Evangelische Landeskirche in Württemberg
 German church records are held separately by Catholic and Protestant authorities for the parsonages in each region.
 I have been unable, so far, to access the Catholic records, but have written to the Evangelical Archive in Stuttgart and obtained copies of the family records for the family of Germanius FLEURY, for the family of Eberhard FLEURY, and for the family of Friedrich FLEURY.
 The family records are very useful because they have a whole family on a single page with each event (baptism, marriage, burial) added to the record over a period of time.

Catholic and Protestant
 Germanius FLEURY is described as Catholic in the information about his family recorded in the Protestant Church archives. I think the GUCKELBERGERS must have been Protestant. The baptisms of Frederika, Beata, and Johanna GUCKELBERGER are in the IGI but there is no indication whether Catholic or Protestant.
 Eberhard FLEURY is not marked as Catholic in his own family record (of the Evangelical Church) so presumably was either raised as a Protestant or was a Protestant convert. Eberhard's sons, Friedrich and Hermann, both had children baptised in Protestant churches.
 The SCHMALZERS were Catholic being baptised in the Catholic Church at Frankenthal.
 The marriage notes for the marriage of Hermann FLEURY and Margaretha SCHALCK indicate that the SCHALCKs were Catholic.

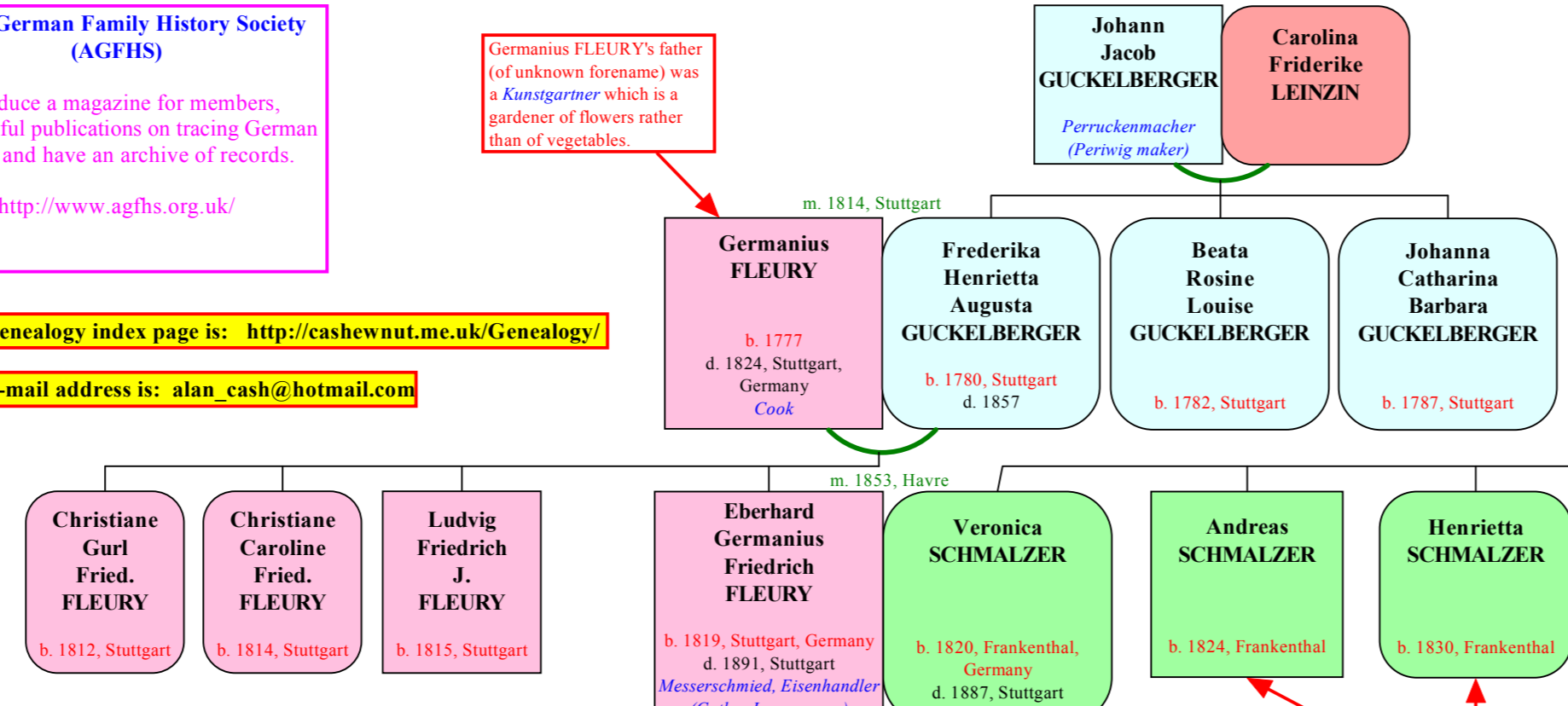
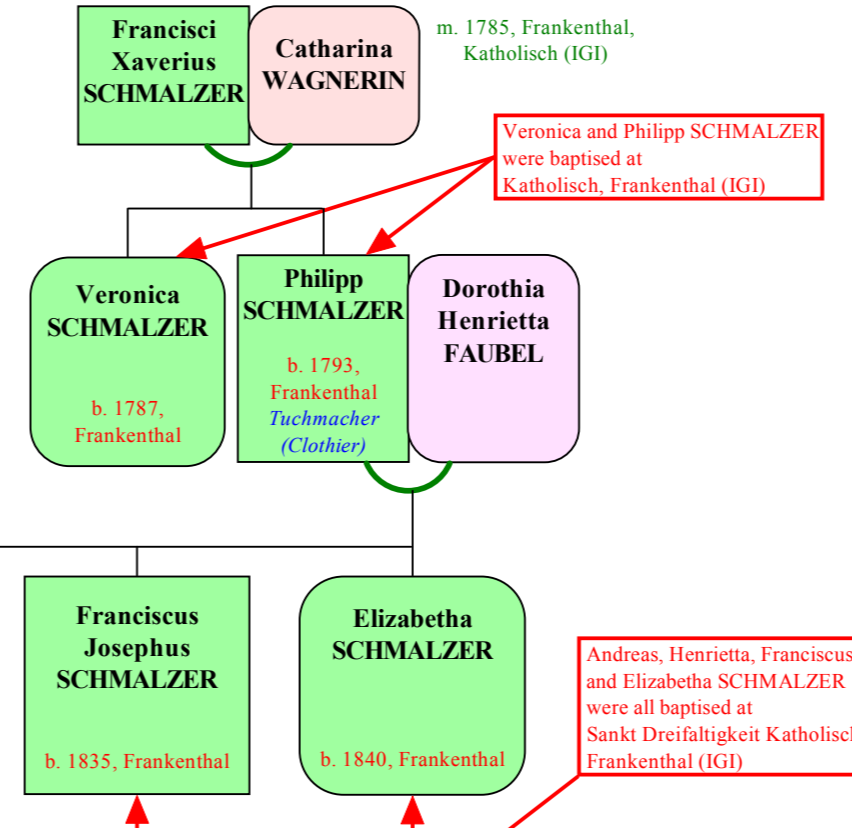
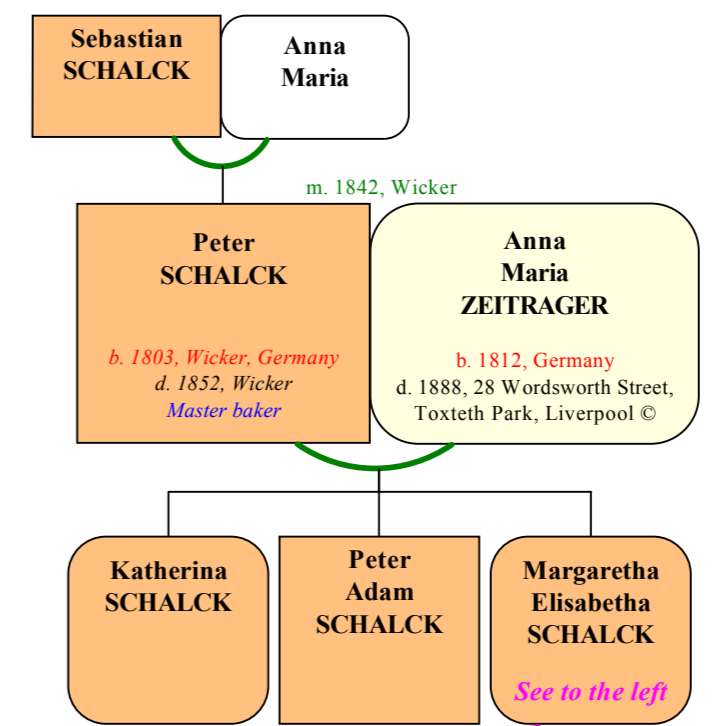
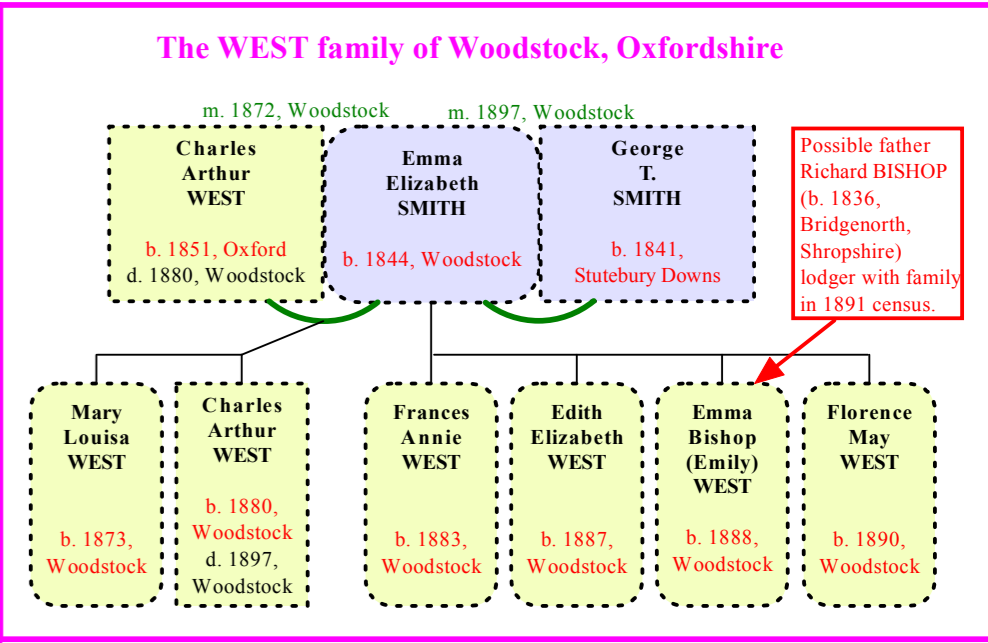

 Some of this information has come on-line from the International Genealogical Index (IGI).

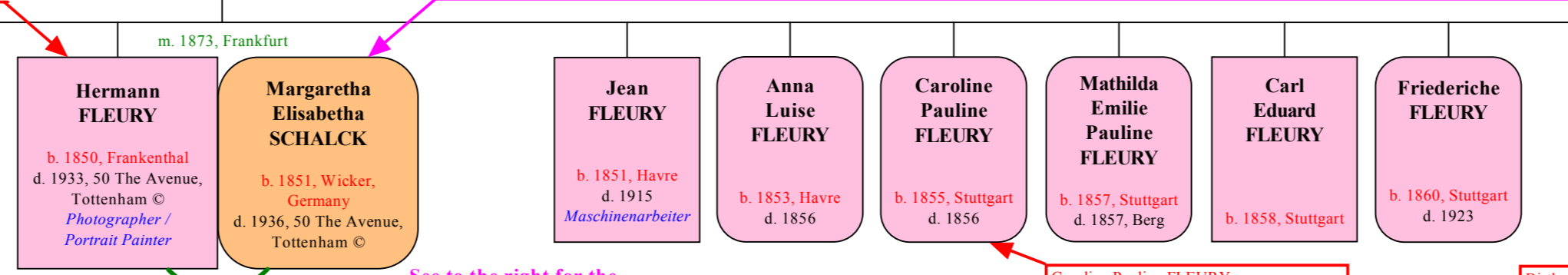
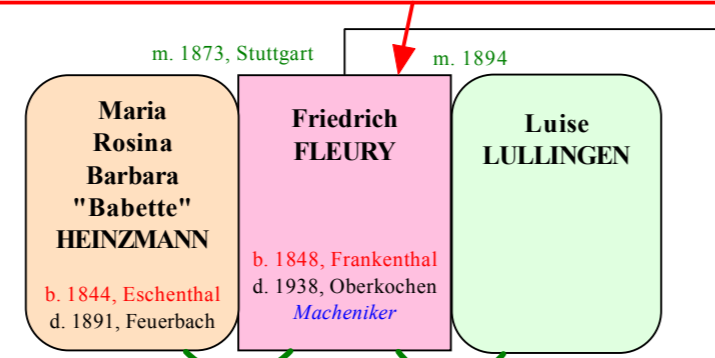

Frankenthal is a small town in the state of Pfalz, near Mannheim, about 100 miles north west of Stuttgart.

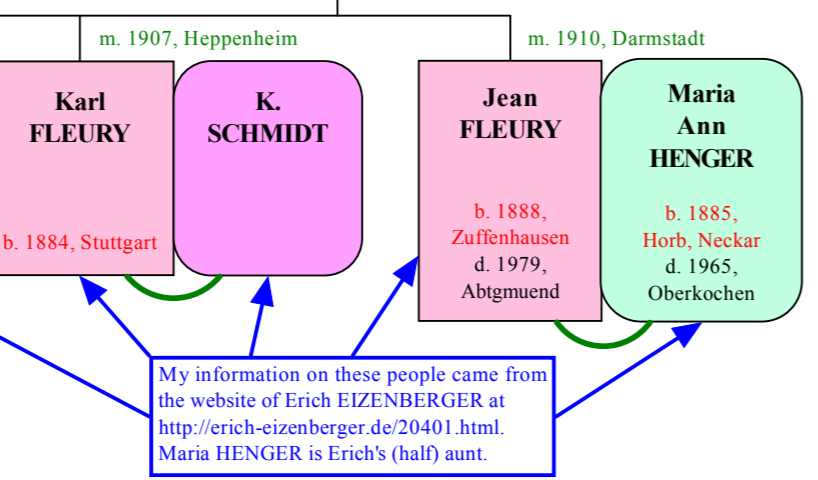
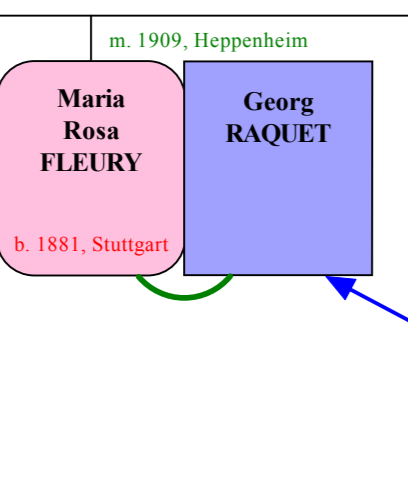
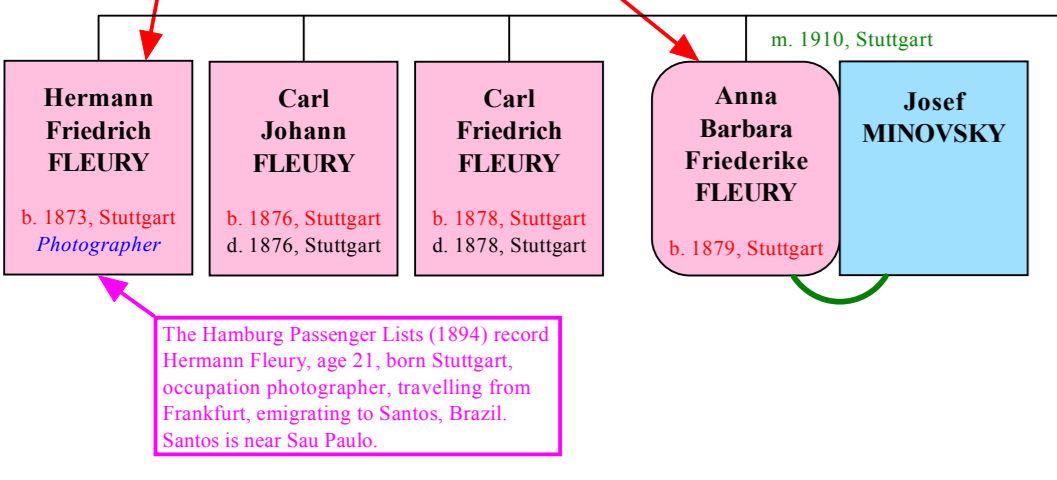

The marriage notes of Hermann FLEURY and Margaretha SCHALCK describe Hermann as "legitimized son" of Eberhard on his marriage to Veronica SCHMALZER (variant spelling of her surname in this document).

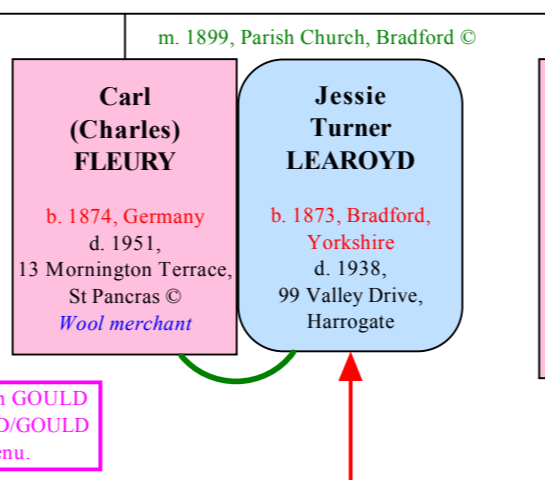


My grandparents Robert and Edith

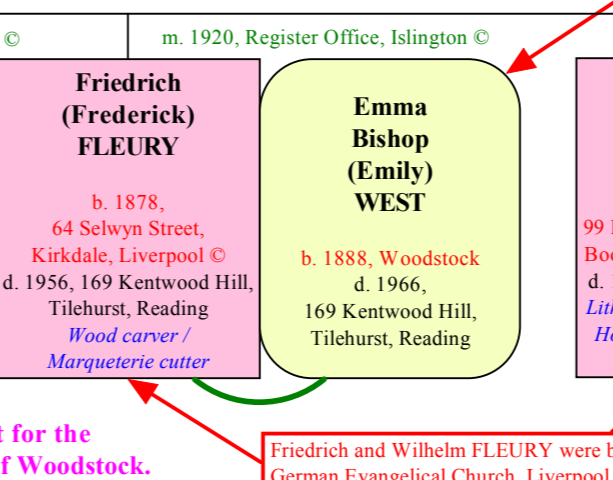
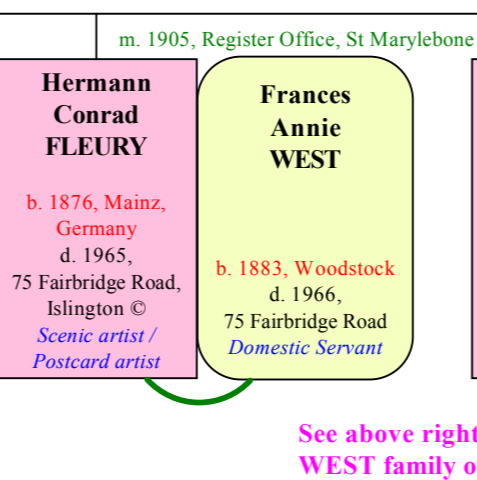
For ancestry of Edith GOULD select surname GOLD/GOULD on my genealogy menu.

When I asked my mother about her uncles some time ago, she said that her uncle Carl remained "up north" when the Fleury family came to London. She recalls that Carl and Jessie did visit once (when my mum was a child) but my mum was at school and did not meet them. She remembers that afterwards, her mother (my grandmother Edith Fleury née Gould) said that, because Carl and Jessie had no children of their own, they wanted to adopt one of my mum's younger siblings (a baby boy, my uncle Paul), but that my grandma said "they are not having any of my children !".

I have recently been contacted by Kathleen Gregson, a Learoyd descendant, who has told me that Jessie's father, Tom Learoyd, was born in 1830 in Huddersfield, son of James Learoyd and Elizabeth née Bottomley. Tom had 7 brothers and 2 sisters. Tom married Emma Crowther, manufacturer's daughter, in 1860 in Halifax, Tom and Emma were Jessie's parents. The Learoyds had woollen mills in Huddersfield. Tom (born 1834, Huddersfield) is described in the records as Commission Agent and Manufacturer of Fancy Woollen Goods.

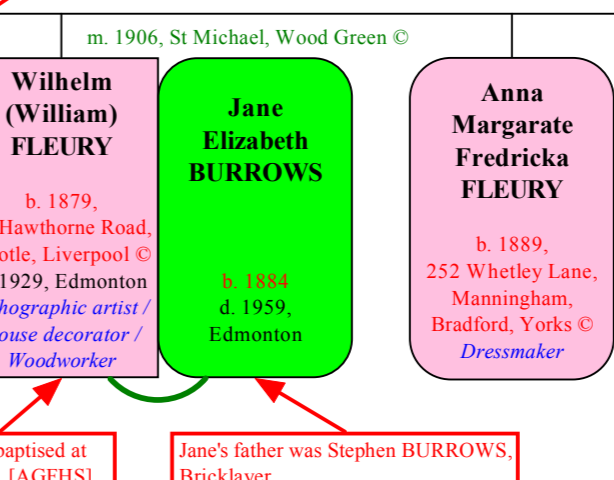

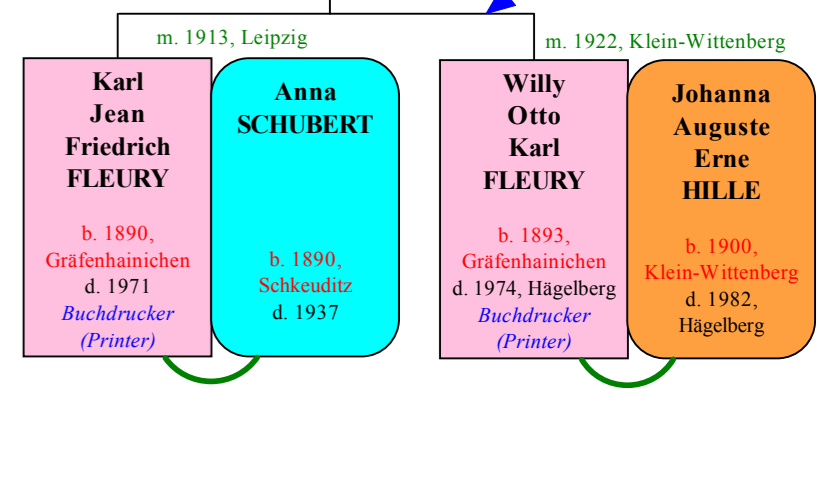


Friedrich and Wilhelm FLEURY were baptised at German Evangelical Church, Liverpool. [AGFHS]
