Although the spelling in the 1863 marriage record (GRO) is Elvina, I have used the more usual spelling.
I think Elvina cannot have been the daughter of Sophia who would have been about 14 when she was born. I am including her in the family because she was present in the 1841 census.

Eliza's baptism is recorded on 11 Mar 1838 as Eliza LORD daughter of George & Sophia (IGI). I cannot find a birth registration in the GRO. Her GRO marriage record of 1856 is in the name Eliza LOYD.

LORD LOYD LLOYD
The ancestral name for this family was LORD according to baptismal records for earlier generations. For some branches, the spelling changed during the nineteenth century to LOYD and then LLOYD. On this chart I have used the surname spelling entered in the GRO birth record where found, or that in the baptismal record, followed by the GRO marriage spelling (in brackets) where that is different.

Margaret's parents were James SMITH, house painter and plasterer, and wife Sarah. Both were born in Bury.
This couple are possibly to be identified with the marriage recorded in the IGI of James SMITH and Sarah BUCKLEY at St Mary Radcliffe, Bury, 19 Feb 1837. Also in the IGI is the baptism of Margaret SMITH, daughter of James & Sarah, on 8 Oct 1837, with the birth on 7 Sep.

Birth entry in GRO (2nd quarter 1851, Depwade reg-district) has the name Louis Loyd LOYD. I have assumed this is a mistake and called this person Louis LOYD.

According to the 1851 and 1861 censuses William's parents were Benjamin & Ann KALLAWAY (various spellings) both born in Richmond, Surrey. Benjamin was a coachman/stableman. Ann was seamstress and charwoman.

The marriage of Caroline's parents was registered in 1856 between Robert LISTER & Dinah COLLINGS.
Caroline's birth was registered (1861 GRO) as Caroline LESTER. Half her siblings were registered also with surname LESTER, but the other half with surname LISTER. In her marriage registration (1886 GRO) her name was Caroline LISTER.

Charles's parents were Charles CLARKE, miller, born Morley, and his wife Lydia [TAYLOR], born Deopham, Norfolk, who were married in 1809 in Deopham.

George also may not be Sophia's son. He was present with the family in 1841, and in addition was recorded as grandson of Jemima [MEAR] LORD in 1851.

In Aslacton on 20 Sept 1840 Harriet ROWLAND was baptised daughter of George and Sarah ROWLAND. Her birth was registered as Harriet ROWLAND (3rd qtr 1840 Depwade reg-district).
The spelling was Harriet ROWLAND in her 1868 marriage record (GRO).

In the 1871 census, Robert is recorded as Robert LOYD, age 9, son of George LOYD.
I have identified this person with Robert ROWLAND whose birth was registered in 1st qtr 1862 in Depwade r-d which includes the village of Aslacton. Robert was born about 6 years before George and Harriet were married. He may be a natural child of Harriet, or perhaps her nephew.
On marriage his name appears as Robert ROWLIND (sic) (GRO 1st qtr 1884 Mutford reg-district).

Birth (1862 GRO), and baptism (1862 IGI), and 1891 census have forename as "Phillis", but marriage (1886 GRO), and 1871 and 1881 censuses have "Phillias". The 1901 census has "Polly".
Her parents were Robert STALKER, felt hat maker, born in Penrith, Cumberland, and Catherine [COTCHER], born in Whitehaven, Cumberland, who were married in 1857 in Cockermouth, Cumberland.

In the first quarter of 1893, Charlotte gave birth to her last child Charlotte, but also lost her husband Louis and daughter Maud. She subsequently returned to Scarborough where the family had been living in 1881 before their move to London. In 1901, Charlotte is a lodging house keeper in Scarborough and has her daughter Charlotte, age 8, with her. I cannot identify William and Fanny in 1901 and do not know if they survived. George and James remained in the London area.

Reginald's birth was registered as Reginald Owen HAMBLING the year before his mother Ellen married Robert ROWLAND. Reginald was recorded as Riginold O. ROWLAND, age 7, son of Robert ROWLAND, in the 1891 census.

The marriage of Ellen's parents was registered in 1847 in Wangford reg-district between Joseph HEMBLING and Maria GARDINER. The parishes of Shadingfield and Ilketshall St Andrew are both within Wangford reg-district. Joseph was born in Ilketshall St Andrew. Maria was born in Shadingfield, Suffolk.
