Minnie's parents were John Spinks MUNNS and Charlotte CLARK, who were married in 1858 (London City registration district). John was born in Chippenham, Cambridgeshire, and was first a gardener (1871) but then in 1881 described himself as "Lauderer & green-grocer, coal & coke merchant employing 1 man and 1 boy." Charlotte [CLARK] was born in London.

Sarah's parents were Henry Francis HAMBLÉN and Sarah Harriet SEAREY, who were married in 1826 at Old Church, Saint Pancras. Henry was born in Falmouth, Cornwall, and was a printer-compositor. William PIGOTT's sister, Margaret Maria PIGOTT, was already married to Sarah's younger brother Charles HAMBLÉN (see to the right on this chart).

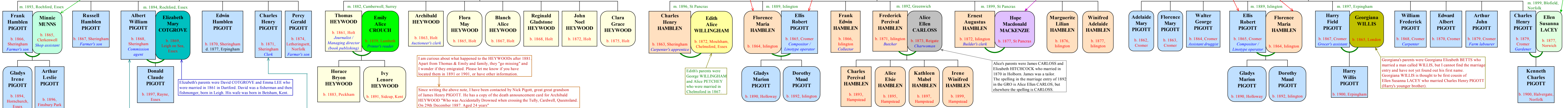
Horace's father was Thomas HEYWOOD, a brewer and malster, born in Prestwick, Lancashire. Thomas's wife Mary was born in Holt.

Spelling Charles HAMBLIN in 1862 GRO marriage record. Charles's older sister Sarah HAMBLÉN later (1865) married Margaret's older brother William PIGOTT (see to the left on this chart).

Hope's parents were William J. MACKENZIE, a granite merchant, and his wife Elizabeth. Both parents were born in Scotland.

Mary's parents were Ellis FIELD, born Gresham, Norfolk, and his wife Mary, born in Great Yarmouth. Ellis was light keeper at Overstrand Lighthouse, where the family lived during Mary's childhood. Overstrand is a mile or so from Cromer on the north Norfolk coast. The spelling of Mary's middle name is Ester on her GRO birth entry, but Easton on marriage.

Ellen's parents were Elijah LACEY and Mary Ann BETTS who were married in 1868 in Norwich. Mary Ann BETTS was sister of Georgiana Elizabeth BETTS whose daughter, Georgiana WILLIS, was already married to Charles Henry PIGOTT's brother, Harry Field PIGOTT.



I am curious about what happened to the HEYWOODS after 1881. Apart from Thomas & Emily and family, they "go missing" and I wonder if they emigrated. Please let me know if you have located them in 1891 or 1901, or have other information.

Since writing the above note, I have been contacted by Nick Pigott, great great grandson of James Henry PIGOTT. He has a copy of the death announcement card for Archibald HEYWOOD "Who was Accidentally Drowned when crossing the Tully, Cardwell, Queensland. On 29th December 1887. Aged 24 years"

I have also been contacted by Sandy Nolde of Australia. Sandy says that Rachel and Horace did emigrate to Australia bringing with them at least four of their children including Blanche (Sandy's great grandmother) who was aged 15 at the time which would make the date of emigration approximately 1882. The family story is that Horace may have returned to England leaving Rachel in Australia. Rachel died in 1924 or 1925 in Townsville, Queensland.

Blanche married Henry (Harry) Aylmer THORNTON (born 22/4/1864, Sidney). The marriage was at Flora's House in West End, Townsville, on 30/10/1887. Children of Blanche and Harry were

- Eleanor Grace THORNTON (b. 1889, d. 1953. She married John STURGEON in 1923, 3 children).
- Flora Blanche THORNTON (b. 1891, d. ~1950. Unmarried).
- Lettie Irene THORNTON (Sandy's gran, b. 1896, d. 1981. She married Albert TILL in 1917, 1 child. After Albert's death Lettie married Andrew HALL, 1921, 7 children).
- Madge THORNTON (b. 1898, d. 1957. She married Rupert ASPINALL in 1922, 1 child).
- Archibald Henry THORNTON (b. 1900, d. 1986. He married Grace SHERMAN in 1920, no children).

Three further children of Blanche and Harry were born after 1900 (not detailed here).

Harry died in 1940 and Blanche died in 1957, both in Townsville.

Clara HEYWOOD (Blanche's sister) married Ernest Edward William Charles BROOKE.

Rachel [PIGOTT] HEYWOOD ran a little store in Cardwell in which Sandy's gran worked for a time.

Albert and Elizabeth had a second son but then Elizabeth died in about 1906.  
Albert married secondly Eugene (Eugenie) Hastings Creer Mason on 21st January, 1907. Eugenie was born on 5th February, 1882. Albert had a further 9 children by his second marriage. Eugenie died in February, 1919.  
After losing his second wife, Albert emigrated to Canada on the SS *Coronia* with his children (all but the first two sons), arriving in Halifax, Nova Scotia in June, 1920. The eldest sons joined them later as did Eugenie's mother Eve Mason who came to look after the children.  
Albert died on February 20th 1935 at Ellis Island Hospital where he worked as a gardener. He was buried in a cemetery in Linden County, New Jersey.

Charles Henry PIGOTT married Ann Elizabeth WESTRUP. Their first child Margery PIGOTT was born in California on 1st March 1896. The family then moved to Comox, British Columbia, where the second child Muriel Ada PIGOTT was born on 9th May 1899. The couple later had five more children. The family had a store, farm and post office in Comox, which is on the eastern coast of Vancouver Island about 60 miles north-west of Nanaimo. (Information from my contact and relative Robin William Pigott.)

Edith's parents were George WILLINGHAM and Alice PETCHEY who were married in Chelmsford in 1867.

Alice's parents were James CARLOSS and Elizabeth HITCHCOCK who married in 1870 in Holborn. James was a tailor. The spelling in the marriage entry of 1892 in the GRO is Alice Ellen CARLOS, but elsewhere the spelling is CARLOSS.

Georgiana's parents were Georgiana Elizabeth BETTS who married a man called WILLIS, but I cannot find the marriage entry and have not yet found out his first name. Georgiana WILLIS is thought to be first cousin of Ellen Susanna LACEY who married Charles Henry PIGOTT (Harry's younger brother).
