Not having access to Wacton registers, I am indebted to my contact Stephen Lord who told me about the marriage between Robert LORD and Jemima MEAR, and the children of this marriage. Without this key information I should not have been able to research this branch and add it to my tree.

**LORD ..... LOYD ..... LLOYD**  
The ancestral name for this family was LORD according to baptismal records for earlier generations. For some branches, the spelling changed during the nineteenth century to LOYD and then LLOYD.  
I have not got access to the baptismal records for Wacton or Long Stratton,

and consequently do not know how the children of Robert & Jemima LORD were recorded. They were born too early to have civil birth registrations which began in the 3rd quarter of 1837.  
In censuses, they appear mostly as LOYD for early ones, and LLOYD for later ones. I have chosen to use the name LOYD for these siblings on this chart.

In the church record for the marriage of George to Sophia BANHAM his name was George LORD (1808 IGI).  
In the civil record for the marriage of Henry to Susan GOODRUM his name was Henry LLOYD (1840 GRO).  
See also the note attached to Diana DYE (to the right).

Susan's marriage record (1840 GRO) has the spelling GOODRUM, but other records have the spellings GOODRAM or GOODERHAM for her family.

Censuses give Charles's wife as Diana (or Dinah in 1861), born around 1905 in Wacton. An entry on Rootsweb from a contributor calling herself "Diana", and researching surname DYE in the Wacton/Tivetshall area reads: "Diana DYE m Charles LORD 29 - 1 - 1835 Wacton"  
This is my sole reason for believing Charles's wife to have been Diana DYE. There is a birth of Diana DYE in Wacton on 18 Sep 1800 to parents Green DYE and Mary [SHIBLEY] in the IGI. This could be the right person.

Emily's parents were James HARDY, a farm labourer born in Hempnall, and his wife Phoebe, born in Tasburgh.  
In 1861, at age 19, Emily gave birth to her son Daniel HARDY. Later that year, she married her first husband William LOVEDAY. Subsequently she had 4 children named LOVEDAY, all born in Tasburgh, who were  
Betsy LOVEDAY (1865),  
William Arthur LOVEDAY (1867),  
Emma LOVEDAY (1869),  
Priscilla LOVEDAY (1871).  
In the 1871 census, Priscilla is recorded as being 3 weeks old, while Emily is widowed. There is a death of a William LOVEDAY recorded in Depwade reg-district (which includes the village of Tasburgh) in the first quarter of 1870, but that William was age 80 when he died. In any case, if this was Emily's husband, he cannot have been Priscilla's father if she was 3 weeks old on census day 1871 (which was 2nd April).

**LORD ..... LOYD ..... LLOYD**  
For this branch I have used the surname spelling entered in the GRO birth record, followed by the GRO marriage spelling (in brackets) where that is different.

Belinda and John were first cousins. John's father James LOYD was brother of Belinda's father Charles. See also BULLEN chart (c1).

John's parents were James BLAZEY and his wife Hannah [YALLOP] who were married on 10 Jan 1814 at Caister St Edmund with Markshall (IGI).

There were 2 Stratton villages, each a separate parish. One was called Stratton St Mary (or more fully Long Stratton St Mary), and a smaller one to the north of this was called Stratton St Michael. They are now merged into one parish usually called Long Stratton.

I am assuming that Mary belongs to this family because she is with them in the 1841 census which does not record relationships. She could, in fact, be a niece, or some other relation of Charles. The other siblings appear as sons or daughters of Charles in 1851.

The spelling can be BLAZY or BLAZEY in the records. John's 1830 birth registration (GRO) and baptism records have BLAZEY, as does his 1851 marriage registration (GRO). His children's births were registered as BLAZEY for John Richard, Harriet, Hannah and Arthur, but as BLAZY for Mary Ann and Susannah Jane. When Susannah Jane married (1884) her name was recorded as BLAZEY (GRO). Walter George's birth registration (GRO) has surname BLAZER which I have assumed was a mistake and have not followed. Otherwise, I have used the GRO birth spelling on this chart.

Lewis's parents were George TAYLOR, carpenter of Oxborough, Norfolk, and his wife Harriet ARCHER, of Catton, who were married in Catton in 1822.  
Lewis's marriage to Susan was his second. His first is thought to be to Lucy TENEN in 1851. She died in 1875.

Walter's name appears in the GRO as Walter George A. BLAZER. (1885 Dec qtr Norfolk r-d) which I assume to be a mistake and have not followed.

Eliza and Jessie were sisters. Their parents were Robert DINGLE an agricultural labourer of Moulton, and his wife Elizabeth [GILBERT] of Beighton, Norfolk, who were married in 1852.

John's parents were David FARLIE, artillery gunner and driver, and Chelsea Pensioner, born in Canterbury, and his wife Mary Ann, born in Wingham, Kent.  
On his marriage (1884), John's wife was recorded as Susannah Jane BLAZEY.

The marriage was registered in 3rd quarter 1886 in Sheppey (Kent) registration district between James DEVLIN and Hannah BLAZEY, but the children were registered with surname DEVLIN (apart from Lilian's which I cannot find), and the 1891 and 1901 censuses have DEVLIN, so I have used that spelling for James senior.

In 1858 (4th qtr Blofield r-d) George BRISTER of Great Plumstead married Mary Ann LOYD.  
The couple appear in 1861 (both age 27, Mary born Pulham), in 1871 (both age 36, Mary born Wacton), in 1881 (both age 47, Mary born Pulham Market), in 1891 (both age 56, Mary born Wacton), and in 1901 (both age 67, Mary born Pulham Market).  
There are no children recorded in any of the censuses.  
I have shown in this chart George married to Mary Ann LOYD, daughter of Robert LOYD, since she was born in Wacton but brought up in Pulham, which could explain the uncertainty of her place of birth in the censuses.  
However, it is possible George married this Mary's cousin, namely Mary Ann LOYD daughter of Charles LOYD, although that Mary was recorded as "invalid" with her parents in Wacton in 1861.

Henry LOYD is present in 1851, age 1, with his grandfather, Robert LOYD, and Robert's 2 daughters who are Susan, age 23, (very recently married to John BLAZEY), and the unmarried Mary Ann LOYD, age 18. I am guessing that Henry is Mary's natural son, but he could be Susan's son, or the son of a sibling of Susan and Mary who I do not know about.  
I cannot find Henry in later censuses and have assumed the death of a Henry LOYD recorded in 1852 is his.

Rachel's parents were Thomas SAUNDERS, a service gas pipe layer, born in Bath, and his wife Sarah, born in Westminster.

Henry appears in the 1881, 1891 and 1901 censuses as Henry (Albert) LLOYD, son of James, but I am identifying him with the birth registration in the first quarter of 1874, of Henry Albert LOVEDAY. Emily and James were married in the third quarter of 1874.
